• Earth Day Update

Nels Huse from Menominee Tribal Enterprise reached out to the Council late last year to discuss possible Earth Day events. Nels has altered his plan to consist of a peace tree initiative where pine trees would be planted at the state Capitol, in Washington D.C., and in communities around the state on Indigenous Peoples Day.

• Regional Economic Diversification Summit (REDS) Update

Chair Hittle, Vice Chair Dallman, and Chief State Forester Berklund are working with the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WECDC) and others tasked with developing initiatives to enhance and diversify Wisconsin's forest products industry that would be suitable for the U.S. Economic Development Administration's Regional Economic Diversification Summit (REDS) process. This group created a white paper on their effort, which will be circulated on Council letterhead to inform stakeholders on the effort and process.
