

Federal Funds – State Implementation

Federal funds for State (normal year)

1. Normal, annual federal funding (Core Grants)
 - a. USDA Forest Service, State & Private Forestry (S&PF)
 - Annual allocation for Urban Forestry, Forest Health, Stewardship, Volunteer Fire Assistance, State Fire Assistance
 - Competitive Landscape Scale Restoration Grants
2. Other competitive grants (partners eligible too)
 - a. Examples: Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, Wood Innovation Grants

IIJA Funds to States

1. Funds to implement Statewide Forest Action Plan – next 5 years
 - a. Projects for first year:
 - Trillion Trees coordination and management
 - Conservation easement management and funds for road maintenance
 - Funding management plan writing for private forestry owners in priority areas as defined in the SFAP
 - Mass timber feasibility study
 - Exploration of a regional Tree Improvement Center
 - Some into Urban Forestry Grants and Weed Management Area Grants

IIJA Funds to States – Program Specific

1. Fire funding
 - a. Wildfire Risk Reduction, Wildfire Preparedness projects

2. Other line items we're monitoring and waiting for info:
 - a. Firewood Banks
 - b. Temporary water crossing structures/skidder bridges
 - c. Reforestation and National Seed Strategy
 - d. Forest Health – invasive species detection, prevention, eradication, and research
 - e. Good Neighbor Authority
