## "CORE' FS FUNDING

This FY, DNR is receiving \$2,283,437 from the FS

- \$195,000 for Forest Health
- \$211,000 for Stewardship
- \$50,000 for Forest Legacy
- \$1,410,937 for Fire
- \$416,500 for Urban Forestry

#### Details:

- 1:1 match
- 5 year agreement
- Funding levels vary

#### NEW FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- AtBC = America the Beautiful Challenge Grant
- BIL = Bipartisan Infrastructure Law
- IJA = Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act (same as BIL)
- IRA = Inflation Reduction Act

## AMERICA THE BEAUTIFUL CHALLENGE GRANT

- \$440 million over five years for grants to be administered by NFWF (National Fish and Wildlife Foundation)
- First call for grants in 2022
- WI DNR submitted 5 proposals, including 2 from Forestry
- None were successful

## BIL/IIJA FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- State Forest Action Plan Implementation Funds
  - \$531,000/year to WI DNR
  - Covers a variety of program needs
  - Submitted proposal & approved
  - Waiting award confirmation
- Revegetation Funding RFI
  - \$160,000/year to WI DNR
  - Focused on tree improvement & seed cleaning
  - Submitted proposal & approved
  - Waiting for award confirmation

#### BIL/IIJA FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

#### Fire Funding

- \$50,000 to Community Wildfire Defense Grants
- \$230,892 to State Fire Assistance
- \$71,530 to Volunteer Fire Assistance
- Submitted proposal & approved
- Waiting award confirmation

#### Forest Health State Capacity Funding

- \$28,000/year to WI DNR
- Supplement WMA grants program
- Submitted proposal

## BIL/IIJA FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- Forest Health High-Priority Invasive Species Projects
  - \$1.785M available each year
  - Forestry departments, colleges & nonprofits eligible
  - Applications due 2/3
- Temporary Bridge Funding Funding
  - \$8M available each year
  - \$175,000 award cap
  - Worked with GLTPA on proposal
  - Submitted proposal to purchase timber mats and temporary bridges for use around the state

#### IRA FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- Urban and Community Forestry
  - \$1.5B available over 5 years
  - State proposals due 2/23
  - No award cap
  - One time award
  - Partnering with variety of groups, including UWEX, UWSP, technical colleges, and more
  - Looking at a potential request of \$15 to \$30 million
