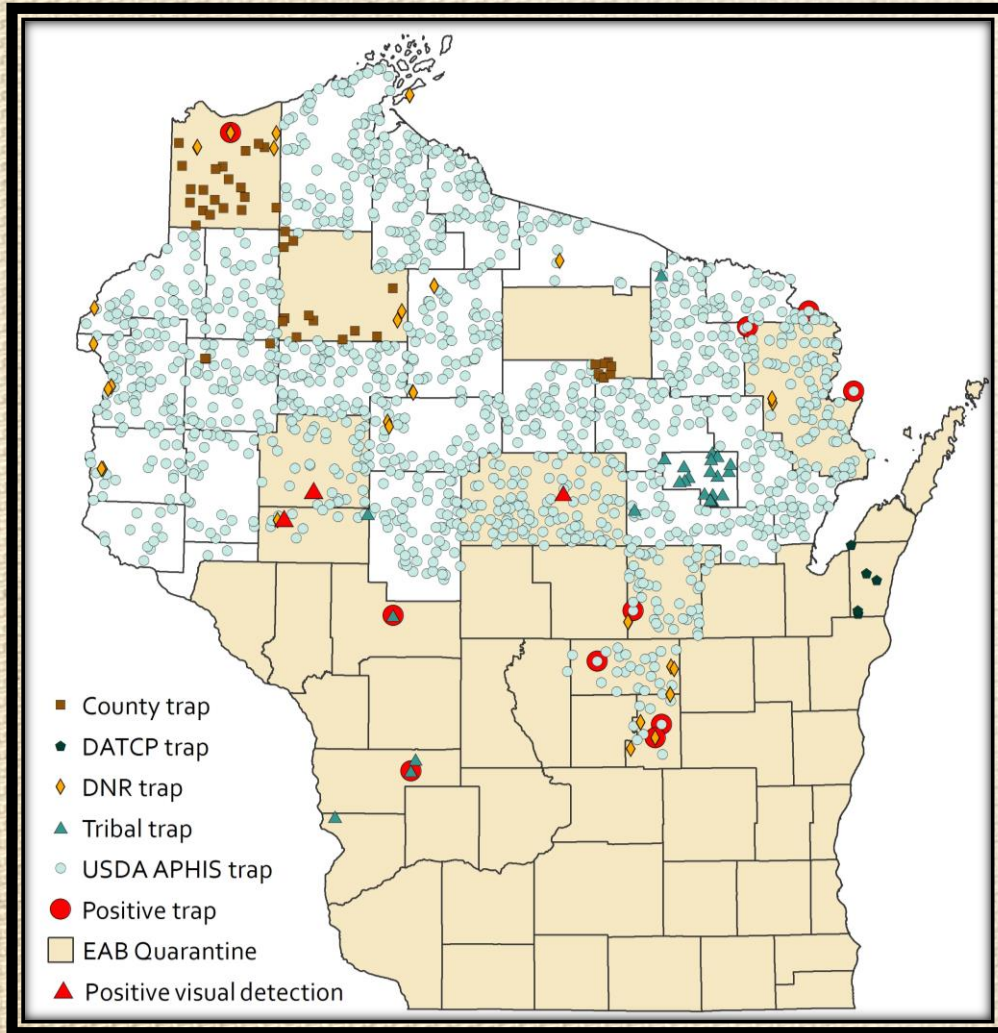

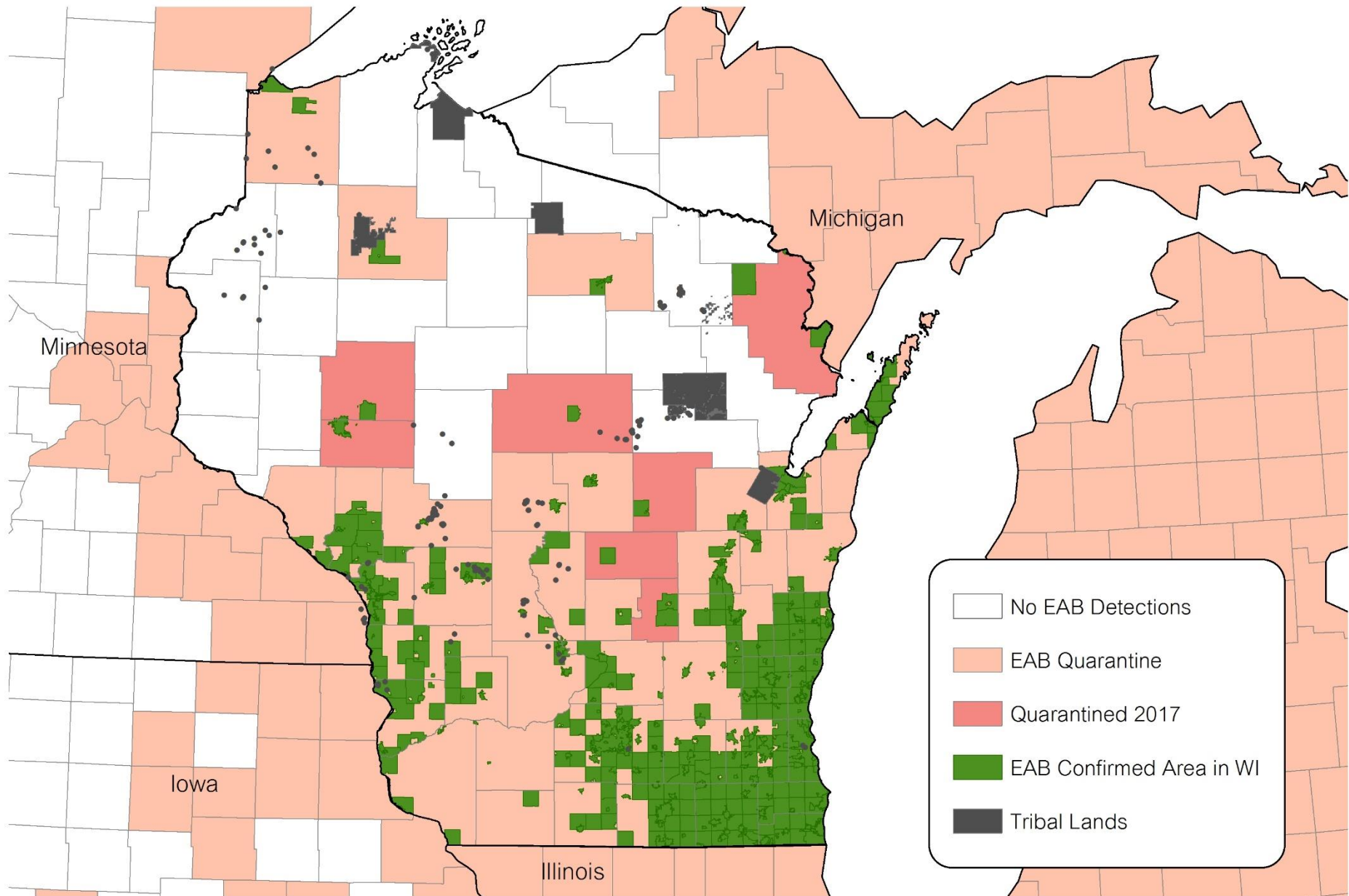

# 2017 Emerald Ash Borer Survey



- APHIS deployed 1,324 traps
- DNR set 38 traps on public lands (mostly state parks)
- DATCP set 5 traps in regulated counties without detections
- County Foresters set 43 traps in northern WI
- Tribal partners set 26 traps
- 10 positive traps; 3 positive visual detections

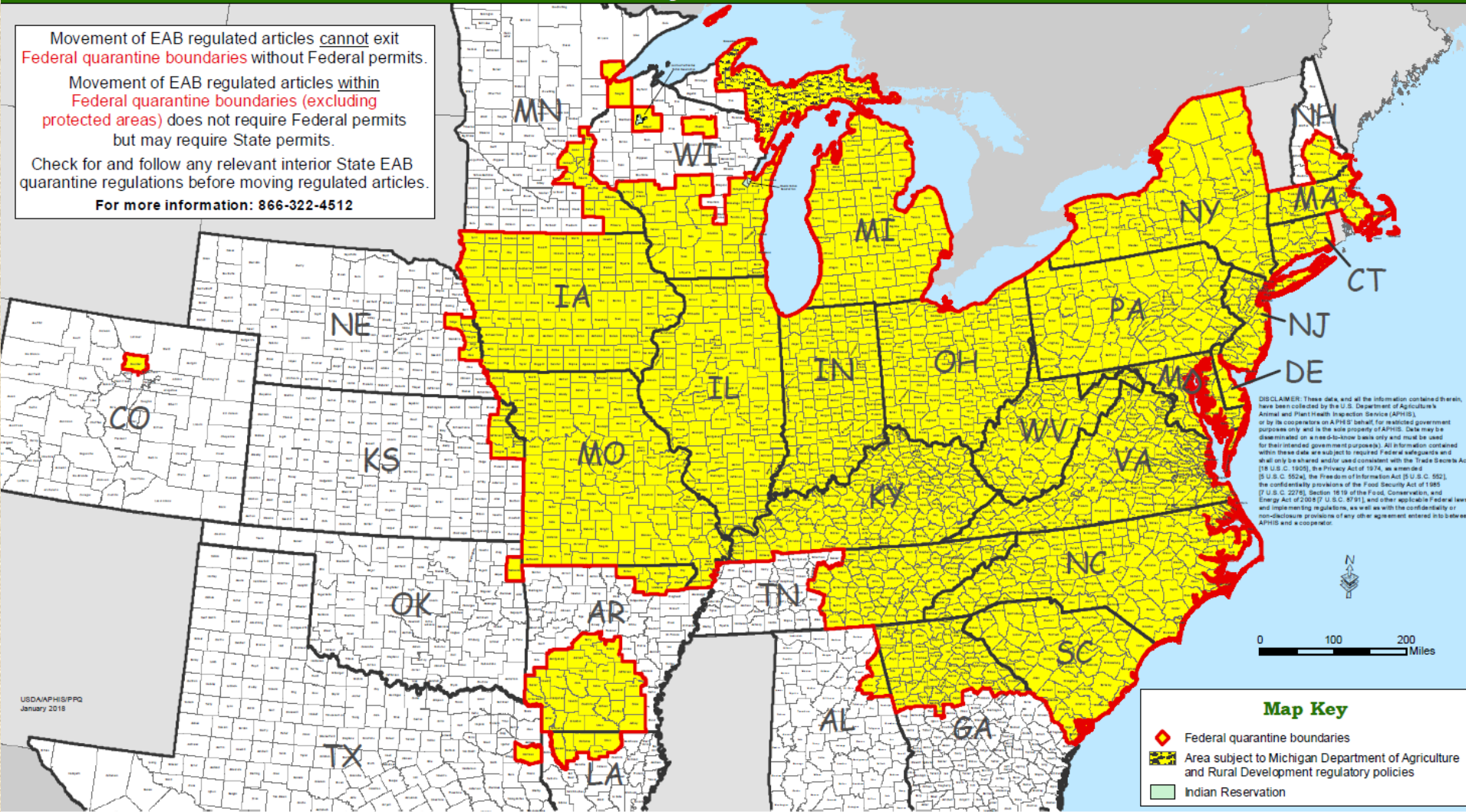

Movement of EAB regulated articles **cannot** exit **Federal quarantine boundaries** without Federal permits.

Movement of EAB regulated articles **within** **Federal quarantine boundaries (excluding protected areas)** does not require Federal permits but may require State permits.

Check for and follow any relevant interior State EAB quarantine regulations before moving regulated articles.

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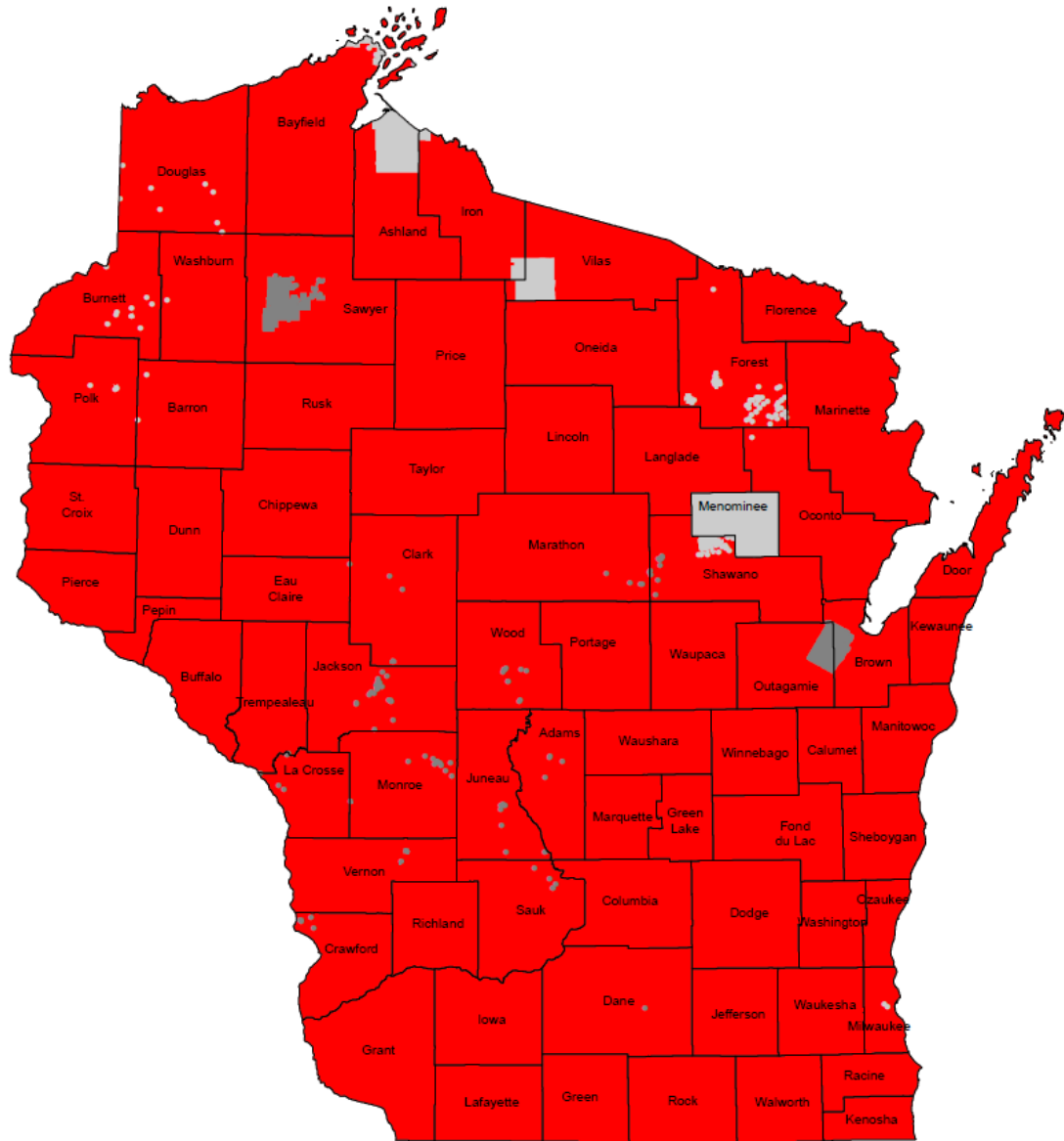

# Statewide Quarantine for EAB

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- **DATCP** will implement a statewide quarantine for EAB on Friday, March 30, 2018 by emergency rule.
- **APHIS** is continuing their conversations with the tribes about the proposed statewide quarantine for EAB. A number of tribes have voiced their position of being against a statewide quarantine.
- A number of industry partners have voiced their support of a statewide quarantine.

# Possible Deregulation of EAB by APHIS

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- APHIS has engaged the tribes and hosted a national conference call on February 13<sup>th</sup>.
- There are more partners to engage in this process and the full federal rule revision process will have to be completed.
- A decision on de-regulation is likely to take at least a year, if not significantly longer.

# Firewood Dealer Certification



- \* WDATCP inspected and certified 31 firewood producers (both new and renewal) in 2017.
- \* Firewood must either be heated to an internal temperature of  $\geq 140$  degrees F for  $\geq 60$  minutes, or seasoned, aka stored onsite for at least 2 years.
- \* DNR State Parks require firewood from  $\leq 10$  miles away or certified firewood; CNNF requires wood to be  $\leq 25$  miles away or certified.

**Firewood regulations for public properties remain in place regardless of EAB quarantine. DATCP and DNR to continue outreach to encourage voluntary precautions!**
