Legislative/DNR solutions

- 1. Increase cost sharing % in WFLGP and create a new funding pool for cost incentives for large (County Forests) and other landowners not qualified for WFLGP
- 2. Dedicated DNR reforestation position to advance regeneration practices, support and network with firms conducting site prep, tree planting, and nurseries
- 3. Establish low interest loan or other financial support for investments in timber industry forestry (including site prep) equipment.

Administrative and Stakeholder Solutions

Seed source

- 4. Raise effectiveness of seed collection campaign
 - a. Work on timing and strategies

Coordination

- 5. Organize a brain trust to solve forest regeneration issues collectively instead of one-off solutions
- 6. Better connect site prep operators with public and private landowners
- 7. NRCS EQIP support for silvicultural practices

Risk Reduction

- 8. Increase stand diversity while growing merchantable pine to reduce risk of loss and market change
- 9. Explore options for insurance for forest loss to offset establishment cost risk
- 10. Approaches to minimize soil disturbance and herbicide use

Communication

- 11. Awareness education for DNR forestry and additional DNR staff other than forestry
- 12. Awareness education for MFL plan writers on options, so landowners are fully informed
- 13. Draft economics example
- 14. Media messaging along with use WI wood campaign on red pine products
- 15. Recognize different needs and messaging for different landowners/audiences
- 16. Social acceptability messaging for even-age forest disturbance and regeneration

Data-driven decisions

- 17. More development of silvicultural options that grow red pine suitable for various markets
- 18. Continue to document acreage where treatment needed so private business can understand need and support investment
- 19. Enhance usability of DNR Forest Regeneration Monitoring to draw conclusions about cause and effect
