

Forest Industry Roadmap Project: Roles & Responsibilities

Stakeholders

Agree with project sponsor on project purpose, goals, deliverables, scope, timeline, and team

Project Sponsor: Wisconsin Paper Council?

- > Decide a project should happen and allocate a project lead
- > Secure funding for project with assistance from project team
- > Agree with Project Lead on project purpose, goals, deliverables, scope, timeline, and team
- ➤ Help solve problems, remove obstacles, and make resources available as needed and requested by Project Lead
- Maintain a good working relationship with major stakeholders from other internal and external organizations and companies.

Project Lead: Council on Forestry

- ➤ Allocate a project manager and agree with project manager on project purpose, goals, deliverables, scope, timeline, and team
- ➤ Help solve problems, remove obstacles, and make resources available as needed and requested by project manager
- Introduce the project to the organization and ask relevant parts of organization to help as needed
- ➤ Give feedback on and approve interim and final deliverables (engage in constructive conflict by giving honest, specific, & actionable feedback)
- ➤ Be ultimately responsible for the project's quality and content: is the project resulting in the desired outcomes?

Project Manager: DNR Contractor & Support staff

- > Create and maintain the project plan (goals, deliverables, scope, timeline, method).
- ➤ Be main point of contact for project sponsor, project lead, committees, and internal and external stakeholders, as named in the project team organizational chart.
- ➤ Be ultimately responsible for the project's process: Is the project proceeding as planned? Is the team doing what we said we'd do? Hold team members accountable to their commitments in the project plan.
- ➤ Proactively alert the project lead of any obstacles or delays in the project quality or process and propose options for fixing.
- > Selectively create project deliverables as committed to in the project plan as able to (while prioritizing the primary project management role for the sub-team).
- ➤ Plan for meetings with the project sponsor, project lead, and committees by scheduling the meetings, creating agendas, compiling needed pre-reads or meeting materials beforehand, and creating action items following each meeting
- Engage in constructive conflict by proactively and honestly raising concerns and objections as needed about the project's purpose, goals, scope, deliverables, work plan, quality, and direction.

Executive Committee

Members (~4): WEDC, DNR, Council Rep(s), BBB Liaison?

- > Smaller committee available to meet frequently with project manager to make quick logistical decisions to keep project moving forward
- Use input from strategic advisory committee to make final recommendations to project manager
- ➤ Attend all working team meetings as requested by Project Manager
- Contribute to development of work plan, create project deliverables with strategic advisory committee
- Engage in constructive conflict by proactively and honestly raising concerns and objections as needed about the project's purpose, goals, scope, deliverables, work plan, quality, and direction

Strategic Advisory Committee

Members (~10): County/regional EDC, UW Extension, Planning commission rep, Industry reps (Logger/TPA/lumber), forest landowner, county forest, workforce/education

- ➤ Larger committee that meets less frequently than executive committee
- Contribute to development of work plan, create project deliverables
- Attend meetings to provide specialized expertise as requested and needed by the project manager
- Engage in constructive conflict by proactively and honestly raising concerns and objections as needed about the project's purpose, goals, scope, deliverables, work plan, quality, and directions
