






Forest-Based Manufacturing Industry Workshop Background

- GLTPA/WCFA invited a group of stakeholders that represent:
 - Foresters, Wood buyers, Loggers and Operators in the forestbased manufacturing industry
- Purpose
 - Provide GLTPA/WCFA input to provide NCASI with information to prepare an RFP to solicit proposals to address topic #2 Economic and ecological consequences (cost/benefits) of forestry policies, regulations and guidelines (PRG)
- Objectives
 - Solicit input on the WDNR forest management policies, guidelines and regulations (PRG) that are economically burdensome;
 - Categorize the cost impact to the industry of the identified PRGs; and
 - Rank the identified PRGs in order of importance.






Forest-Based Manufacturing Industry Workshop Summary(1)

- Participants
 - 11 representing the logging sector, pulp/paper mills, sawmills, REITs, consulting foresters (TIMOs/NIPFs).
- Facilitators and Workshop Support
 - GLTPA, WCFA, NCASI, WDNR staff, Senator Tom Tiffany
- Participants identified 5 Broad Economically Burdensome Topics.
 - Seasonal Harvesting Restrictions
 - Managed Forest Law Administration
 - General Harvesting Restrictions
 - Forest Certification
 - Permits






Forest-Based Manufacturing Industry Workshop Summary(2)

- Participants identified for each Broad Topic the respective WDNR forest management policies, guidelines and regulations (PRG) that are economically burdensome and as much as possible specifically identified the economic impact.
- Participants discussed and ranked each PRG and agreed on the cost impact to the industry. The summary is a follows:
 - 22 PRGs ranked High industry decline/shut down
 - 6 PRGs ranked Medium industry stable/decline
 - 6 PRGs ranked Low –industry growth potential/stable
- Following the meeting the participants ranked the importance of the identified Broad Topic and PRGs.






Broad Economically Burdensome Topics








Seasonal Harvesting Restrictions










