<u>Responsibilities :</u>


- Support CoF charge **review** by September 2013
- Div. of Forestry implement programs that protect and sustainably manage WI's forest resources
- Scientific info may contain uncertainty may necessitate the application of **precautionary principles and practices**
- Liaison between AC and constituencies
- **Be Respectful** of other AC members viewpoints
- Work with Technical Team to resolve concerns and make recommendations on guidelines in a **timely manner**
- Attend and be an active participant we need your experience

Decision Making Process:

- The AC will reach decisions via a system of **team consensus**
- Every member will have **opportunity to express their views**, divergent views will be fully addressed
- Ideally, a satisfactory level of **general agreement** emerges
- Consensus is an **agreement** not necessarily complete agreement
- Outcome "Close enough" to be acceptable (All or most team members can support it; few or no oppose)
- Consensus is **not a unanimous** decision

It is our charge to reach Consensus. If we cannot those items will be brought to the CoF for a decision.
